 Tree is dying.  
 Orig. 24", now 24" B. Oak S. 66° W. 26.4 ft., dying, shows good  
 scar. We did not open.  
 New BT's: 12" D. Fir S. 24° E. 20.6 ft. Mkd:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S5 CS BT.
