Found - Orig. D. Fir, now 26", N. 12° E. 33.7 ft., shows good scars but burnt face, faint scribe makes visible. 184  
Orig. 18", now 20" D. Fir, S. 32° E. 17.3 ft., scribe visible.  
Orig. 16" D. Fir, now stub, S. 26° W. 24.4 ft., shows good scar.  
Orig. 18", now 28" D. Fir, N. 40° W. 90.4 ft., shows good scars.

Orig. 16" D. Fir, now stump, pushed out of ground, S. 35° W. 21.1 ft., opened for scribe "B".  
Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 31 S R 9 W
