Orig. 20" Fir, now Stump, N. 48° W. 19.8 ft., shows good scar.

Orig. 20" Fir, now 29", S. 30° W. 36.6 ft., shows good scar.
Orig. 24" Port Orford Cedar, now stump, N. 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 37.0 ft., shows scribing "S18 T31S R9W BT".

Orig. 30" D. Fir, now stump, S. 60° E. 7.9 ft., shows good scar.
Orig. 12" D. Fir, now stump, N. 58° W. 44.2 ft., scribe visible but not legible.

Orig. 14" D. Fir, now 18", S. 32° W. 16.5 ft., shows good scar.
