1/4 Corner to Sections 16 and 21. 34
Found - Stone 18x12x5 ins. marked "1/4" on the North face.
Orig. 60" Fir, now snag with burnt face, bears S. 60° E. 21.7 ft.
Set - 2"x30" galv. I.P. with Brass Cap, stamped: T 32 S R 2 W
1/4 S 16
S 21
From the pipe monument, I marked the following trees: 1968 OLS 536
13" Fir bears N. 53° E. 14.3 ft. mkd: "1/4" S16 BT.
8" Fir bears S. 58 1/2° E. 10.5 ft. mkd: "1/4" S21 BT.
Placed BT tags on all bearing trees & facing the monument.

1/4 Corner to Sections 21 and 22. 35
Found - Stone 18x12x6 ins., marked "1/4" on west face. #130
Orig. 14", now 24" Fir with scribes in poor condition bears S. 24° W. 31.0 ft.
Set - 2"x30" galv. I.P. with Brass Cap, stamped: T 32 S R 2 W
1/4 S 21 | S 22

From the pipe monument, I marked:
15" White Fir bears N. 68° E. 20.7 ft. mkd: "1/4" S22 BT".
24" Fir bearing S. 24° W. 31.0 ft. mkd: "1/4" S21 BT" (remarked)
Placed BT tags on all bearing trees and facing the monument.

Section Corner to Sections 16 - 17 - 20 - 21. 36
Found - A stone, well eroded.
Orig. 34", now 40" fir, with open face, bears N. 80° E. 121.4 ft.
Set - Brass Cap on 2"x30" galv. I.P., stamped: T 32 S R 2 W

From the Pipe Monument, I marked:
12" Fir bears N. 27° E. 11.6 ft. mkd: T32S R2W S16 BT.
13" Fir bears S. 41° E. 44.7 ft. mkd: T32S R2W S21 BT.
15" Fir bears S. 18° W. 43.8 ft. mkd: T32S R2W S20 BT.
15" Fir bears N. 42° W. 9.9 ft. mkd: T32S R2W S17 BT.
Placed BT tags on all bearing trees and facing the monument.

1/4 Corner to Sections 20 and 21. 37
Found - Stone 24x10x8 ins. marked "1/4" on west face.
Orig. 24" Fir, now stump, bears N. 89° E. 17.2 ft. with scribes in good condition.
Orig. 36", now 40" Fir, bears S. 23° W. 25.8 ft. with open face & scribes in good condition.
Set - 2"x30" galv. I.P. with Brass Cap stamped: #125 T 32 S R 2 W
1/4 S 20 | S 21

From the Iron Pipe Monument, I Marked:
9" Fir bears S. 48° E. 7.3 ft. mkd: "1/4" S21 BT".
Placed BT tags on all bearing trees and facing the monument.

1/4 Corner to Sections 17 and 20. 38
Found - Stone 24x12x5 ins. mardk. "1/4" on the north face.
Orig. 28", now 36" Fir, bears S. 30° W. 28.3 ft., with closed face.
Orig. 30", now 40" Sugar Pine, bears N. 10° W. 20.1 ft., opened the face and found scribes in good condition.
Set - 2"x30" galv. I.P. with Brass Cap, stamped: T 32 S R 2 W
1/4 S 17
S 20
Placed BT tags on all bearing trees and facing mont. 1968 OLS 536

Section Corner to Sections 17 - 18 - 19 - 20. 39
Found - Stone 18x10x6 ins. with 3 notches on S. & 5 notches on E. edges.
Orig. 36" Fir, now snag, with good scribes bears N. 35° E. 7.3 ft.
Set - 2"x30" galv. I.P. with Brass Cap, stamped: T 32 S R 2 W

From the Pipe Monument, I marked a:
20" Hemlock T32S R2W S17 BT bears N. 67 1/2° E. 58.0 ft.
8" Fir T32S R2W S20 BT bears S. 22° E. 33.2 ft. (Placed BT tags on all
16" Fir T32S R2W S19 BT bears S. 25° W. 47.2 ft. (bearing trees, & facing
10" Fir T32S R2W S18 BT bears N. 58° W. 32.0 ft. monument)
