old Witness Trees. He just set a post for the corner #223
from which:

Laurel 8 Ins. Diam., Bears EAST 13 Lks. dist

CORNER SECTIONS 11 and 12. 5

RE-RENEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 48
Stone 6" x 8" x 14" marked X, from which
A White Oak 12" bears S. 55° W., 29 lks. Remarked
A Pine 18" dia. bears S. 78 1/2° E., 74 lks.

SECTION CORNER ON SOUTH SIDE OF SECTION 35. 6

Post in place but rotted off. Fifty inch Fir B.T.
as described in Government Field notes.
Drove 1 1/2" x 60" Iron pipe for corner with 6" sq.
Yew Wood post alongside.
A 16" Fir N. 13° W., 108 lks., reblazed and so
Reblazed and scribed original B.T.
A 50" Fir S. 52° E., 71 lks.

SECTION CORNER 34 and 35 on Township line. 7

Found 8" x 10" x 4" above ground Basaltic Stone as
described in Government Field Notes. Original B.T.s in
good shape which I reblaze and mark, as follows
A 10" Fir N. 23° 30' E., 86 lks.
A 10" Fir S. 41° W., 52 lks.
A 6" Sugar Pine N. 51° W., 55 lks.

CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 and 20. 8

RE-RENEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 11
Black Oak 3 1/2" dia. bears S. 49° W., 43 lks.
Black Oak 1 1/2" dia. bears S. 51° W., 57 lks.

CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 14 and 11. 9

I set corner per original Field notes. One bearing tree
cut down. I took stump as B.T. and put in new tree
A White Oak marked 1/4 S. C.S. 8" dia. bears S. 3° 45' N.,
338 lks.
