$\frac{1}{4}$ Corner for Section 31 (south side), T32S, R6W.
Orig. - Post (missing, point is 3.00 ch. W. of N $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 6) from which a:
4" Laurel (Madrone) bears N.55°W. 59 lks.; now 15", center rotted.
4" Live Oak bears N.52°E. 27 lks.; now 14" stub with sprouts coming up around edge.
Restored - Set 3" round by 5' alum. painted Fir Post 18" in ground, from which a:
13" Sugar Pine bears N.86°W. 49.5 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.
4" Live Oak bears N.33°E. 67.0 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.
12" Sugar Pine bears S.89°E. 25.8 ft.; scribed RS359.
Ore.St.Forestry Dept. metal location poster on 12" Sugar Pine.

$\frac{1}{4}$ Corner for Section 6 (north side) T33-6W. *FD. OK 8/90 M112-14* *FD OK BY G. NYGREN 3/94 M118-79* **24**

Orig. - Post (now missing, found recent post in place) from which a:
15" Fir bears S.59°W. 117 lks.; now 49", scribes 14 visible.
3" Laurel (Madrone) bears S.33°E. 97 lks.; now 14" burnt stub, log down hill.
Rest. - by R. L. Templin (RE 3024) date unknown. See Ren. No. 12.
Post (above) from which a:
13" Fir bears N.39°W. 5.0 ft.; scribes $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 RE3024 BT visible.
Rest. - Set - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" gal. I.P. with 3" br. cap mkd: "Ore.St.Ed. of Forestry $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 1964 RS 359", 33" in ground, and from which a:
15" Fir bears S.2°W. 35.8 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BT.
12" Fir bears N.49°E. 12.3 ft.; scribed RS 359.
Set - 3" round by 5 ft. alum. painted Fir Post 1.0 ft. NW. of corner pipe.
Ore.St.Forestry Dept. metal location poster on above 12" Fir.

Orig. - Yew Post (missing) from which a:
12" Laurel S.55°E. 12 lks.; now root hole & stubs of burned out Madrone in place, sprouts around edge.
15" Laurel bears N.80°W. 18 lks.; now 27", portion of ancient cruiser markings, in cut out face, no scribes remaining.
Old line blazes N. and S. - Top Ridge, course E, 7.00 ch. S; in place. Creek, course East, 4.00 chains North; in place.
Restored - Set - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" gal. I.P. with 3" br. cap mkd: "Ore.St.Ed. of Forestry $\frac{1}{4}$ S5 S6 1964 RS359", 30" in gr, & from which:
27" Madrone (Orig) bears N.80°W. 11.9 ft.; Rescribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BTRS359.
10" Chinquapin bears S.21°E. 10.6 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S5 BT.
56" Fir Stump bears N.68°W. 32.2 ft.; scribed RS359.
Set - 4x4x62" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NE of corner pipe.
Ore.St.Forestry Dept. metal location poster on above 56" Fir Stump.
