

# REPORT OF SURVEYOR

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Oregon

GENTLEMEN:

I have the honor to report that, pursuant to your order of date June 5 1919, in the matter of \_\_\_\_\_ of a certain road as petitioned for by George Marsh and others I met with John I. Chapman & J. B. Sarge Viewers at the Beginning Point of Said Road in Road Dist. No. 12 Precinct on the 16th day of June 1919, and under the direction of said Viewers, proceeded to survey said road as petitioned for, conspicuously marking the same throughout; and noting the courses and distances; and I do hereby certify that the following is a correct return of the survey of said road, and plat of the same, viz:

I Ran the Center Line of a 40 ft. Roadway 70 ft. of which lies on each side of the following described survey, to wit:
