

Harmsen and Wakefield

This survey was started from the South quarter corner of section 31, T.28 S; R.8 W. which is six feet east of an iron bar driven at a fence corner; Harmsen and Wakefield who bought this property from Mr Whiting requested a needle line survey only inasmuch as the value of the property would not justify subdividing the entire section, so a needle line was run around this forty and the corners of the property were set at 1320 ft, distances except as shown at the N.W. corner where Mr Whiting deeded a 200 x 400 ft tract to his mother-in-law for a home. It should be noted that this is not an accurate survey and was not intended to show any close lines but only approximate ones since it will not be fenced by the present owners who bought it primarily for a mill site.

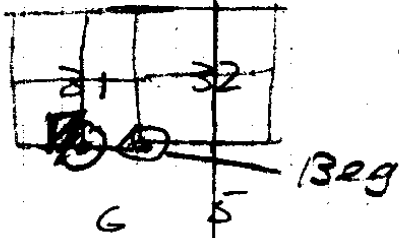
