A tract of land the boundaries of which are described as follows, BEGINNING at a 3/4 inch round steel bar on the West bank of a fish pond and 1.5 ft West of a 6 inch maple tree, said beginning point being 2199.7 ft. North and 531.7 ft. West of the quarter section corner between sections 1 and 12, T.26 S; R.3 W; W.M., thence running N.80°-07'W., 104.5 ft. to a 1 1/2 inch iron pipe on the left or East bank of Rock Creek, thence following along along said bank of creek, up stream, N.29°-57'E. 105.2 ft. to a point and N.50°-33'E 105.0 ft. to a 1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe, thence leaving left bank of creek and running S.9°-52'W. 178.0 ft to the place of beginning, containing 0.26 of an acre, more or less, all the above in Section 1, T.26 S; R. 3 W; Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon.
