Beginning at a point, on the present Logging Road, which is 482.5 ft. South and 509.5 ft. West of the North East corner of Section 25, Twp. 29 S., R. 10 W., Willamette Meridian, thence N. 43° E; 150.0 ft; thence N. 42° 02' W; 503.2 ft; to a point on the North section line of said Section 25, (the above survey being on center line of said Logging Road) which is 678.9 ft. West of the North East corner of said section 25, and that this map has been prepared for the approval of The Secretary of the Interior in order that I may obtain the benefits of the Acts of Congress of January 21, 1895, and May 11, 1898 "right of way to tramroads across the public lands of the United States."
