For vacation of part of Umpqua Boule- )

This matter coming on for hearing upon the petition of J W Mess and Joanna E Mess for the vacation of that part of Umpqua Boulevard located in Umpqua Park Addition to the City of Roseburg, Douglas County, Oregon, lying between the north line of Portland Street and the north line of the plat of said Addition, being one block in length; and

IT APPEARING that said petitioners are the owners of all of Block 1 of said Umpqua Park Addition and all of the property on the adjoining side of a part of said Umpqua Boulevard sought to be vacated and that they are the only persons who would be particularly affected by said vacation; and

It further APPEARING that the vacation of said part of said boulevard would not deny access of any person whomsoever to any property owned by them and that said part of said boulevard is wholly unimproved and has never actually been used as a street or thoroughfare and that there is not now any need for the same; and

It further APPEARING that notice of the filing of said petition has been given, as required by law, by the posting of a notice thereof, which said notice was posted in three of the most public or conspicuous places within the limits of said Addition, to-wit: one on Umpqua Boulevard in Alexander's park; one on Portland Street in Umpqua Park Addition; and one on Block 1 of said Umpqua Park Addition.

It is, therefore, CONSIDERED, ORDERED and ADJUDGED that all of that part of Umpqua Boulevard lying in Umpqua Park Addition of the City of Roseburg, Douglas County, Oregon, and lying between the north line of Portland Street and the north line of the plat of said addition, being one block in length, be and the same hereby is vacated.
