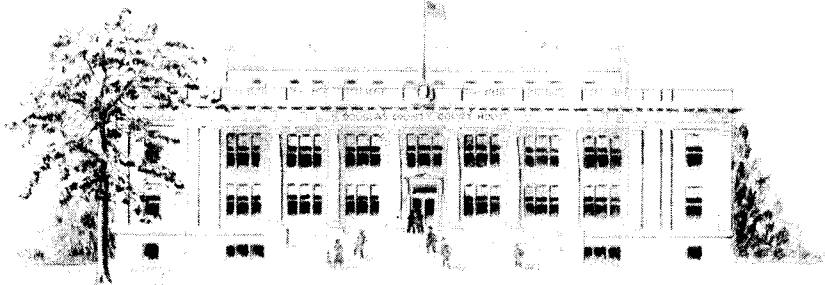

HARRY BRYSON      THE OAKS ADD.

That portion of Lot No. 10 of The Oaks Addition to Roseburg, in Section 26, Twp. 27 S; Rg. 6 W; of the Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon, which is described as follows,-

BEGINNING at the Northeasterly corner of Lot #10 of The Oaks Addition to Roseburg, Oregon, on the westerly side of County Road No. 114, and running thence along the westerly side of said road, S.40°-45'W. 170.0 ft; S.35°-10'W. 166.8 ft. and S.30°-20'W. 166.8 ft. thence leaving said road and running N.53°W. 353.0 ft. to the south bank of the South Umpqua River, thence running downstream, along said river bank, N.25°E. 321.0 ft. and N.38°-30'E. 321.0 ft. thence leaving said river bank and running S.35°E. 419.1 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 5.0 acres, more or less.
