

LOCATED IN SEC. 29 & 30, T25 S, R5 W, W.M.

Mr L. A. Wood requested a survey to determine the North line of Lot 6 Block 1 Plat H.

On August 27 1929 I started work to determine such line. Stakes as originally set were in place at the NE, SE, and SW corners of the lot. The pipe called for as the initial point of the subdivision had apparently been removed when the corner fence post was placed. I renewed this by placing a sandstone 6"x12" 27" long 18" in the ground and marking said roal with a X on top and OS on the NE face. I measured the distance from the SE corner as established to the NE corner and found it to be exactly as called for in the plat. I drove an iron rod alongside this original corner post so that its location might be perserved. I then went to the side of the lot next to Pacific Highway and from the intersection of the south line of the plat with the center of the Highway measured off along the senter of the highway the distance shown on the plat. I then measured from this last determined point to the NE corner of Lot 6 and found such distance to be 535.6 ft or 1 ft less than the distance given on the plat. This line is about a foot North of a row of Pear trees at the Highway end and about the same distance South of the same row of trees at the RR end. This would give to each of the adjoining property owners a half interest in said row of trees.
