I do hereby certify that I am president of the CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY, that BEN. B. IRVING, who subscribed to the accompanying affidavit was employed by the said company to make the survey; that the survey of said power line, as accuratelyately represented on this map and by the accompanying field notes, was made under authority of the company; that the company is duly authorized by its articles of incorporation to construct said power lines upon the location shown upon this map; that the said power line, as represented on this map and by said field notes, was adopted by the company on the day of as the definite location of said power line described as follows - Beginning at a point on the North line of section 3 T. 31 S., R. 5 W., W.M. 88° ft East of the N.W. corner thereof, Thence running in a general Southerly direction 4126.6 ft. to the Government Air Beacon; and that this map has been filed for the approval of the Secretary of the Interior in order that the company may obtain the benefits of the Act of Congress of Feb. 15, 1901, and I further certify that the right of way hereby desired is for the main purpose of power transmission.

IRVING, being duly sworn, says he is the person employed by the CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY to survey said power line for which right of way is asked as required under Act of Congress of Feb. 15, 1901, being a total length of 4126.6 ft., was made by him as the surveyor employed by the company and under its authority commenced on the 14th day of November 1930 and that such survey is accurately represented on this map and by the accompanying field notes. The said power line is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of section 3 T. 31 S., R. 5 W., W.M. 88° ft East of the N.W. corner thereof, Thence running in a general Southerly direction 4126.6 ft. to the Government Air Beacon.
