Irving who subscribed to the accompanying affidavit was employed by me to make the survey represented on the accompanying map; that the survey of the said logging truck road as accurately represented on the accompanying map and by the accompanying field notes was made under my authority and that the said field notes were adopted as the definite location of the said logging truck road described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Section 3 T.30S., R.9W., of Willamette Meridian, which point is $N10^{\circ}22' W 969^3 ft.$ from the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner on the west side of said Section, thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the route represented on the said map $9315^3 ft.$ to a point on the east line of said Section 3 from which the northeast corner of said section 3 bears North $2921 ft.$ and that this map has been prepared for the approval of the Secretary of the Interior in order that I may obtain the benefits of the Acts of Congress of January 21 1895 and May 11, 1898 "right of way to tramroads across the public lands of the United States".
