 Benjamin Huntington and L. D. Doain, for the vacation of certain lots,
 blocks, streets and alleys in South Doain, Douglas County, Oregon.
 And it satisfactorily appears to the Court that the portion of said town
 plat asked to be vacated is not within any incorporated town or city
 and that the said Petitioners are, respectively the owners in fee of all
 that portion of said town plat described in said application and which
 is asked to be vacated, and that there are no persons to be particularly
 affected by the vacation of that portion of said town plat,
 and it appearing that proper notice has been given by posting in three
 Public places in South Doain notices of the application of said vacation
 said notices being so posted 30 days immediately preceding the date.
 And it appearing to the Court that said premises, although platted into
 town lots as in said Petition alleged, is only valuable for agricultural
 purposes and that said premises by reason of being so platted is rendered
 much less valuable.

It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Court that the following described
 parts and portions of said townsite be and the same are hereby annulled
 and vacated, to-wit: Lots 4 and 5 of Block 30, Lot 4, in Block 31, all of Blocks
 40 and 41, 50 and 51; also the following Streets and Alleys, Douglas
 Street, Ash Street, Bass Street, from intersection with Cedar Street
 to Elk Creek, Lane Street, from intersection with Cedar Street to
 Elk Street, Beech Street, from the North line of Lot 4 in Block 31, to
 Douglas Street, all that portion of that certain alley extending
 through Blocks 50, 40 and between Lots 4 and 5 in Block 30, also that
 certain alley extending through Blocks 51, 41 and between Lots 4 & 5
 in Block 31, as said Townsite appears of Record at page 1 of Volume
 1 Record of Plats of said Douglas County, Oregon

Drain, for the vacation of certain Lots, Blocks, Streets, and Alleys, in South Drain, Douglas County, Oregon and it satisfactorily appears to the Court that the portion of said town plat asked to be vacated is not within any incorporated town or city and that the said petetioners are respectively the owners in fee of all that portion of said town plat described in said application and which is asked to be vacated, and that there are no persons to be particularly affected by the vacation of that portion of said town plat and it appearing that proper notice has been given by posting in three public places in South Drain, notices of the application of said vacation, said notices being so posted 30 days immediately preceding this date, and it appearing to the Court that said premises, although platted into town lots as in said petition alleged, is only valuable for agricultural purposes and that said premises by reason of being so platted is rendered much less valuable.

It is therefor ordered and adjudged by the Court that the following described parts and portions of said townsite be and the same are hereby annulled and vacated, to-wit:- Lots 4 and 5 of Block 30, Lot 4 in Block 31, all of Blocks 40 and 41, 50 and 51, also the following streets and alleys, Douglas Street, Ash Street, Cass Street, from intersection with Cedar Street to Elk Creek, Lane Street from intersection with Cedar Street to Elk Street, Beech Street, from the North line of Lot 4 in Block 31 to Douglas Street, all that portion of that certain alley extending through Blocks 50, 40 and between Lots 4 and 5, of Block 30 also that certain alley extending through Blocks 51, 41, and between Lots 4 and 5 in Block 31 as said Townsite appears of record on page 1 of volume 1, record of Plats of said Douglas County, Oregon.

Court now adjourns for the term.
