Dear Sir:-

Not long ago I had occasion to go over to the Umpqua valley above Scottsburg for the Bridge Lumber Company of Reedsport, and in connection with the work a Mr. Brown pointed out to me the Meander Corner on the right bank of the Umpqua River on the line between Sections 4 and 9, Township 22 South, Range 8 West of W.M. which was an old stake properly scribed. An old fir stump in very poor shape sets N. 29° 30' W. 29.8 feet, but the scribing was still plain when I cut into the stump.

New bearing trees were marked as follows:-

An 8" oak bears N. 7° 30' E. 26.6 feet, scribed M.C. S.4 BT.

A 10" oak bears S. 51° 30' E. 28.6 feet, scribed M.C. S. 9, BT.

At Mr. Brown's request, I marked the above trees and promised to record the notes, as he was interested in preserving the corner.
