WALES SERVICE STATION TRACT

Beginning at the Southeast corner, an iron rod set in the ground, from which the one-fourth Section Corner on South Line of Section 32, Township 23 South, Range 5 West, Willamette meridian, Douglas County, Oregon, bears South  $12^{\circ} 22'$  West 190.0 feet to said section line, and North  $89^{\circ} 44'$  West 880.0 feet along said section line; 880.0 feet; thence North  $12^{\circ} 22'$  East, along the revised right-of-way line of Pacific Highway No. 99, 912.8 feet to an iron rod set in the ground; thence North  $77^{\circ} 38'$  West 225.92 feet to an iron rod set in the ground; thence South  $17^{\circ} 40'$  West 615.15 feet to an iron rod set in the ground; thence South  $77^{\circ} 38'$  East 135.55 feet to an iron rod set in the ground; thence South  $6^{\circ} 10'$  West 302.0 feet to an iron rod set in the ground; thence South  $77^{\circ} 38'$  East 115.0 feet to the place of beginning, containing 4.502 acres, more or less, being a part and parcel of that tract of land deeded to Jas. G. Wales and Bertha I. Wales by Carlen T. Glenville and Marion K. Glenville as recorded at Page 192 of Vol. 121 of Deeds, Douglas County, Oregon.
