DESCRIPTION OF ACCESS ROAD

Beginning at the Northeast Corner fence post of 55.9 acre tract sold to Franklin P. Eggers and wife by James G. Wales and wife, from which the one-fourth section corner on the South line of Section 32, Township 23 South, Range 5 West, of Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon, bears South  $89^{\circ} 41'$  West 1963.6 feet and South  $0^{\circ} 10'$  East 2603.15 feet; thence South  $89^{\circ} 41'$  West 30.5 feet to an iron rod set in the ground; thence South  $48^{\circ} 47'$  West 379.85 feet to an iron rod set in the ground; thence South  $41^{\circ} 13'$  East 20 feet to an iron rod set in the ground on the westerly right-of-way line of relocated Pacific Highway No. 99; thence North  $48^{\circ} 47'$  East along the most Northerly course of said Eggers tract 402.9 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.18 acre, more or less.
