Dear Sir;

In a survey for cutting timber in Sec. 8; T.32 S.; R.4 W., I found that the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. between Sec.9 and Sec. 8 as given in the field notes, did not apply to Sec. 8 according to the plat, hence ran a line from the N.E. Sec. Cor. Sec. 8 to the S.E. Sec. Cor. Sec. 8, found it to be a distance of 4574.5 feet. Therefore at 2604.3 feet from the N.E. Sec. Cor., set,-

A 4" fir post 4' long, firmly in the ground, scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 8, also crayoned marked 1543, from which,  
A fir 12" dia. bears N. 33° W, 32.4'dist. Scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$ S8BT.  
A fir 42" " " S.55° W , 41.6' " " " .
