Begin at the quarter section corner between sections 32 and 33 T<sub>1</sub>N. 24 S. R 7 W. old bearing tree found  
Run South from corner 12.25 chains set an iron pipe 3/4 inch by 36 inches (On top of ridge) marked a Fir 24 in diameter bears North 67 degrees East 5 feet with proper mark  
A Chicapin 18 inches in diameter bears South 46.5 degrees West 22.4 feet thence running South 76 degrees and 10 minute West 6.00 chains to an iron pipe from which a Fir 20 inches in diameter bears North 59 East 36 feet and Marked A Cedar 12 inches in diameter bears South 11 degrees East 30 feet and marked. thence North 63 degrees and 50 minutes West 13.50 chains an iron pipe 3/4 inch by 36 inches long from which a White Fir 18 inches in diameter bears South 81 degrees West 18 feet and marked. A White Fir 12 ins in diameter bears North 19 degrees West 61.5 feet and marked. thence North 41 degrees and 20 minutes West 15.40 chains to a 3/4 inch gal iron pipe by 36 inches long from which a Black Oak 18 inches in diameter bears North 89 degrees East 36 feet and marked. A Fir 18 inches in diameter bears North 43 degrees West 11.8 feet and marked. thence following board fence North 25 degrees 7.94 chains to North side of County Road at 11.20 chains set iron pipe thence North 33 East 3.80 chains to River Bank. set an iron pipe 3/4 inch by 48 inches long. thence following the meanders of the River Northeasterly to the line between sections 32 & 33 thence South on section line 1.75 chains to beg. point Cont 65.14 acres more or less.
