

FOR THE COR. TO SECS. 14,15,22, and 23, T32S, R8W, W.M.

I find a Sugar Pine, 50" diam., bears $N42^{\circ}W$, 163 Lks. dist. marked as described (this tree was cut for a logging landing) a Chinquapin sprout, bears $S70^{\circ}W$, 29 Lks. dist., a Laurel sprout, bears, $S60^{\circ}E$, 14 Lks. dist., a Laurel Sprout, bears $N35^{\circ}E$, 95 Lks, dist. from these trees I drive a 1" iron bolt 30" in length, 24" in the ground, from which a Fir, 17" Diam., bears $N35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$, 42.6 Ft. dist. marked 3642 B.T.

A Fir, 12" diam., bears $S79\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$, 47.0 Ft., marked 3642 B.T.

A Sugar Pine, 22" diam., bears $S57\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$, 86.1 Ft., marked 3642 B.T.

A Fir, 12" diam., bears $N57\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$, 46.9 Ft., marked 3642 B.T.
