Dear Sir;-

Between the dates of July 11, 1955 and August 10, 1955; using a transit, long band chain, and range pole, I ran the section line between section 7 and section 8, T.33 S., R.4 W.W.M., from the south to the north for Mr. Ryce Wilson and with his assistance setting the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner at mid point of line being 2639.5 feet, consisting of:-
A $\frac{3}{4}$ " o.d.galv. iron pipe 36" long set in the ground with a mound of stone 18" high surrounding the pipe ,
from which;-

A r.fir 30" in dia. Bears N.34°E., 31.4 feet dist.
bark scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S.8 B T 1543

A r.fir 18" in dia. bears S.29° W., 41.6 feet
dist. scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 7 B T 1543

Some one , unknown to me, placed a stake witnessed by a fir tree marked $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor.at 15.3' N. and 42' W. of the corner I sat. Cut brush indicates he came in from the east.
