- 14" Fir bears S39°E 10.1' fd. scribe.  
At cor. pt. fd. stone mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$   
from which
- A 15" Fir bears N31°E 68.0' on  
slope mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 B.T. on bark.
- A 25" Alder bears S57°W 137.0'  
on slope mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 T31S R3W B.T.
- A 30" Hemlock bears S75°W  
163.0' on slope mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 B.T.
- Stouts Creek bears South 145.0'

• The logging road will be  
built  thru  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. that  
is why I picked new trees  
at such distance.
