

1/4 Corner 15 | 14 T 31 S-R 5 W-WM

FOUND: Stone 14" x 8" x 6" - 10" in ground marked 1/4 on West Side Cedar snag S 45° E 12 LKS burned and no scribing visible. Stump hole from a Fir tree N 62° W 56 LKS. The stone appears to have never been touched since it was originally set.

SET: 1 1/4" iron Pipe 36" long 2 1/4" in the ground - it replaces the stone which is still there as a memorial. I set the following new Bearing Trees.

18"	Fir	N 41° W - 23.5'	scribed	1/4 S 15 BT
12"	Yew	S 33° E - 34.5'	scribed	1/4 S 14 BT
