NOTE: Deed bearing of North boundary $S60^{\circ}E$ used as base bearing. Traverse ran along boundaries with angles turned in deflection and read to 1 min. All angles doubled. Measurements carefully made along slope with a 300 ft steel tape. Vertical angles read from transit and reduced to horizontal. Existing property lines as delineated by fences have been used for many years and have been accepted by respective owners as proper boundaries. Deviation of fence in west boundary made as construction convenience on account of a small canyon.
