SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Richard R. Ecker, do despose and say that I have surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and accurate description:

"Beginning at a point on the East boundary of the David Ridenhour D.L.C., a 1 1/2" x 3/8" Galvanized Iron Pipe, from which the Northeast corner of said claim bears North, 1369.3'; thence South, 790.0'; thence N89°57'E, 1294.7' to a point on the West R/W line of the county road; thence along said R/W line, N18°14'W, 223.7'; thence continuing along the R/W line, N7°32'W, 580.0'; thence leaving said R/W, bearing S89°57'W, 1149.5' to the place of beginning; all situated in Section 2, T26S, R7W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.
