



NOTE:-  
 CENTER LINES OF CANYON ST. AND FIRST ST. WERE SET OFF BY TURNING THE ANGLES FROM THE CENTER LINES OF THIRD ST. AND MAIN ST., AS SHOWN FROM THE SURVEY BEARINGS AND FOUND STREET MONUMENTS ESTABLISHED BY BAKER IN 1948, SEE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S FILE 40/104, IN THIS OFFICE. AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTER LINES THUS DETERMINED AND 20" UNDERGROUND, WAS FOUND A SET ROCK, WITH NO MARKS IN EVIDENCE. A CROSS WAS CHISELLED IN THIS FOUND ROCK, AT THE INTERSECTION.  
 CORNERS OF LOT 8, BLOCK 6 WERE SET BY PROPORTIONAL MEASUREMENTS, AFTER THE STREET WIDTHS HAD BEEN DEDUCTED.
