ORDER VACATING
RIGHT-OF-WAY
Docket No. 806

WHEREAS, this Court did, on the 4th day of August, 1953, pass a resolution to vacate an unused portion of right-of-way of the Old North Umpqua Road No. 4-B in Section 19, T. 26 S., R. 3 W., W.M., as of record in Road Record 2 at page 272, Court Journal 3 at page 107; the portion proposed to be vacated being hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, thereafter and on August 6, 1953, the County Road Engineer pursuant to said resolution made his report to this Court recommending that said right-of-way be vacated for the reasons (1) that there is no necessity or advisability of preserving the same for the general road system in the future; (2) that the road as constructed and maintained for more than 30 years has been located west of said right-of-way, and that the owners of property over which said road is maintained have agreed to deed the county a 50-foot right-of-way for the present traveled road in exchange for vacation of the unused portion of the old road; and (3) that the public at large will be benefited by the vacation thereof and the resulting correction of road records of Douglas County; and

WHEREAS, upon the filing of said report, this Court did direct the County Engineer to post notices of hearing of said report recommending such vacation and thereafter and on the 11th day of August, 1953, said County Road Engineer did post four notices of the hearing in the following places, to-wit: One on a power pole in front of the Glide Store; one on the back of the Glide Store; and one on a tree near the south line of Glide School property, all being public and conspicuous places in the vicinity of said unused right-of-way proposed to be vacated and in Douglas County, Oregon, and one at the Court house in Roseburg, Douglas County, Oregon; all of which notices were posted more than 30 days prior to the hearing of said report, and particularly notified all persons that said report recommending the vacation of said unused portion of right-of-way would come on for hearing on the 15th day of September, 1953, at 10:00 o'clock a.m., in the Court Room of the above entitled Court; and

WHEREAS, due proof of posting said notices was made by affidavit and filed in this court as by law required; and

WHEREAS, no objections have been made or filed to the vacation of said unused portion of right-of-way, and it would be for the benefit of the public that said unused right-of-way be vacated,

It is, therefore, HEREBY ORDERED that the following described portion of Old North Umpqua Road No. 4-B, to-wit:

A strip of land 60 feet in width, lying 30 feet on each side of the following described center line: Beginning at a point which is South 1° 46' West 60 feet from the Northwest corner of the Thomas Shrum D.L.C. No. 42; thence South 1° 46' West along the west line of said D.L.C. No. 42, a distance of 435.5 feet to the south line of Glide School District No. 12 property, all in Section 19, T. 26 S., R. 3 W., W.M.,
