READ BEARINGS TO BOTH TREES FROM THIS POINT. THE BEARING TO THE N.E. TREE FITS GOOD. THE BEARING TO TREE TO THE SOUTH IS $S 2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ INSTEAD OF $S 2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ AS CALLED FOR IN ^{40 FT} NOTES. SET 1" PIPE WITH BRASS CAP MKD.
