ALSO FIND 2 FIR STUMPS GOOD SCRIBING FACE TO CORNER. THUS 12" FIR BEARS N 24° W 19.6 SCRIBED 1/2 S 7 BT.

12" FIR BEARS 561°E 12.8' GOOD SCRIBING.
