I just haven't been able to remember anything about the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sect 27/34 T21S R4W.

I was there about 1942 or 48. I do remember finding a stump with scribe on that line but it probably was at the west side, it was on an old landing.

I also remember a $\frac{1}{4}$ but I believe it was the E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34. The B.T. was in poor shape and I think it was N.W. of corner. It was on a point sloping south.

That N $\frac{1}{4}$ could have been on real flat ground in brush patch and had some wind falls. If I was there I might remember
