DEFINITELY MADE BY AXE BUT ONLY
ONE STRAIGHT SCRIBE MARK. CUT OPEN
TOP OF UPPER BLAZE AND FOUND
PARTIAL SCRIBE MARKS ABOVE BURNED
PORTION. RING COUNT SHOWS FACE
TO HAVE BEEN MADE APPROX. 100 YRS.
