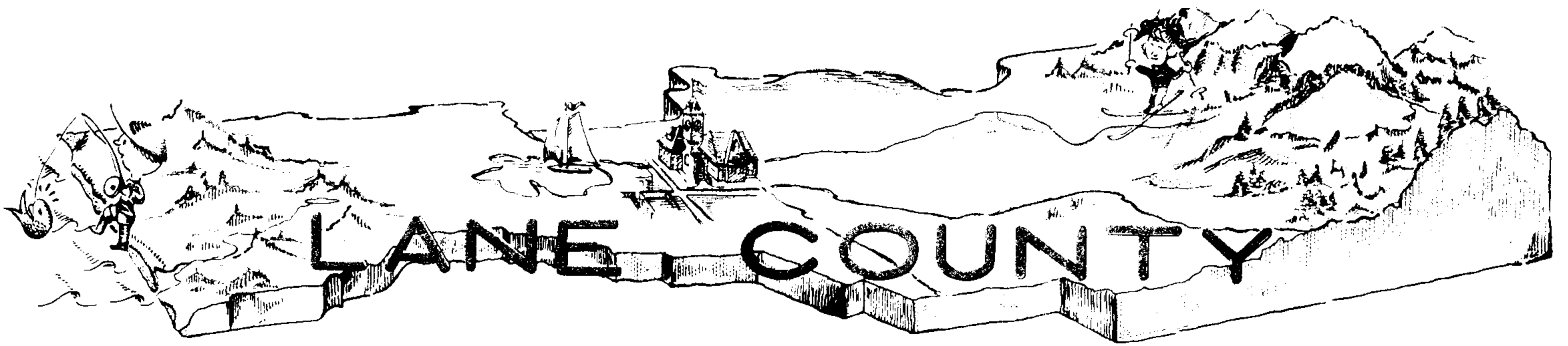

Dear Sir:

With reference to your inquiry by letter dated June 5, 1958 regarding the closing lines and corners of Sections 18 and 19, Township 20 South, Range 6 West and Sections 13 and 24, Township 20 South, Range 7 West, I enclose prints of three maps. The two maps by Gilbert Gardner you may keep for your files. The map by Norman R. Edmondson, dated June 1954, I must ask you to return since I do not have a reproducible medium of that one.

You will see that there is a very definite problem along the Range line and it is my understanding that the Government considers the wedge between the Range lines a hiatus and unsurveyed area.

In the fall of 1954, I made two trips to the location of the questionable area. On one trip Mr. Ganong was present and no solution was found nor can I offer any at this time.

Near the point for the west quarter corner of Section 18, Township 20 South, Range 6 West, the area has been searched and re-searched and all faint clues have most probably been destroyed, though it is very possible that the sandstone marked with 4 notches, instead of  $\frac{1}{4}$ , is a corner set by Mr. McClung.

This information may be of some help to you.
