AT COR. FIND PART OF ROCK MOUND - ROCKS PLACED IN A CIRCLE,

FIND WHITE OAK TREE - NOW 17" DIAM. - S 52° E 95 FT. THIS TREE SHOWED SCARS. OPENED TREE AND FOUND IT HAD BEEN OPENED ABOUT 60 YEARS AGO. CENTER ROTTED OUT.

FOUND ASH TREE - NOW 28" DIAM. - N 65° W 42.9 FT. THIS TREE HAD BEEN REBLAZED. SCRIBE MARKS VISIBLE IN STILL OPEN UPPER & LOWER FACES APPROX. 3" INSIDE PRESENT BARK. PROBABLY STEWART'S SCRIBING. THROUGH AN OPENING IN THE N.E. FACE I COULD SEE THAT THE ENTIRE CENTER OF THE TREE HAS ROTTED AWAY.

AT COR. SET IRON PIPE WITH BRASS CAP MARKED "COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE 1959 T 24 S R 4 W 1/4 S 26 1/2" BUILT MOUND OF ROCKS AROUND COR.
