OUT BUT NO SCRIBING OR SCRIBE
MARKS AS RAMSEY STATES. THE BEST
CUT OUT OF OLD FACE WAS DONE
YEARS AGO. WE DO NOT FIND
THE N W BT THERE IS A DOWN AND
ROTTEN FIR WITHIN A FEW FEET
OF THE 1896 "N W" BT THERE IS NO
EVIDENCE LEFT TO INDICATE THAT
IT WAS A BT.
