Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your inquiry of December 14, 1962, requesting type maps for Twps. 32 and 33 South, Range 7 West, and information regarding the 1/4 corner between Sections 2 and 11, T. 33 S., R. 7 W., W.M. in the Rattlesnake Creek drainage.

Enclosed herewith are subject maps. The 1/4 corner in question was recovered by BLM personnel in November, 1962, during the course of a timber sale layout in Section 11.

Bearing trees witnessing this corner are as follows:

Douglas-fir stump "1/4 S BT" S30°W 26 links  
Madrone (no face remaining) N 3°W 34 links

Said trees were duly posted with yellow BLM BT posters and a 1-1/2" x 30" axle shaft was set at the corner point. This point lies approximately 13 chains west of Rattlesnake Creek and 1-1/2 chains south of an old GLO poster on the Rattlesnake Creek Road.

A blazed line running south misses the 1/4 corner point approximately 1/2 chain to the west. The section line was run from the 1/4 corner west to the NW section corner. This line is brushed and closes 27 links south of the NW section corner. Declination was therefore found to be 18°30' E, line bearing being S89°30'W.

This line will be adjusted and posted in the near future and will coincide with very old blazes found at certain locations along said line. The 1/4 corner was monumented due to the poor condition of the witness trees and it may be that the county surveyor will be interested in perpetuating this corner by scribing additional trees.
