At Corner of Secs. 9, 10, 15, 16, has been reestablished by the Gov. Surveyor with a copper head iron post and four new Bearing Trees, the NW one has been cut leaving a marked stump.

May 23, 1950

Corners 15, 16, 21, 22. The SE BT of about 75 in. diam. dead and face partly chopped out shows S R in upper face and T in the lower face. From this I set a Cedar post in place. From this new BTs

At Cor. 16, 17, 20, 21, found the corner well preserved except the SW Hemlock BT is a rotten stump. marks still readable. For this I put a Yewwood post in place.

May 22, 1950

For Cor. 8, 9, 16, 17, I found a Fir facing SE marked S9 and was about 26 in. at time it was marked. As it lines up to dist. and line with the other corners of the Sec. I concluded these were small errors and set a post for corner; from which brs.

Said Fir 54 in. diam. N 47 1/2°W 9.9 ft.
