Old B. T. an ash 12" S 18°W 30 lks. Down with new tree growing
on old trunk. Could find no figures. Old B. T. a chittim 6"
N 60°W 15 lks. gone. Found old trunk at proper place but no
figures and could not positively locate the exact spot where it
stood. Mr. J. B. Ruscher stated on Dec. 22, 1909 that the old
post stood at or was the point that I placed the new corner.
I also run the South boundary of Cl. No. 38 and it agrees both
for direction and distance and also seems to agree with a pre-
vious survey made in the early days. Set new post marked C.S.
from which A R.B. Cedar Brs. N 19°E 47 lks marked C.S.B.T
