Identified old Gov. Cor. by vine maple stub 5" in dia. which has been cut off and was nearly entirely decayed but marks could be identified sufficient to know that it was one of the original B.Ts. bearing S 10°W 6 lks. dist. from old Gov. stake. The B. T. for Sec. 11 was entirely obliterated. Here set new a vine maple stake 4" square, 4 ft. long, set 2 ft. in ground marked ¼ S 11 C. S. on North face and ¼ S 14 C S on South face from which an alder 8" diam. brs. N 10° E 26 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S. 11 C.S.B.T. A vine maple 6" diam. brs. S 35½° E. 7 lks dist. marked ¼ S 14 C.S.B.T.

S. E. Cor. of Sec. 33 T 18 S R 7 W. W. M. ✓

Identified old gov't corner by means of a small dead ash 10" diam. which had been a bearing tree to said cor. bearing from same N 47° W 48 lks. but had been overturned by the wind and was badly decayed, however the gov't mark sec. 33 was still legible; the other witness tree, a small fir bearing N 37°E 10 lks. had been uprooted and entirely decayed except a little portion of the top.

Here I set new a crab apple stake 5" sq. 48" long, set 24" into ground marked C.C.C.S. on North face, T 18 S S 34 C. S. on East face, T 19 S S 4 C S on S. face, R 7 W S 33 C S on W. face with 3 notches on E face and 3 notches on W. face.

An ash 8" diam. brs. N 29° E 67 lks dist mkd T 18 S R 7 W S 34 C.S.B.T.
