 no marks on it. Old B. T. a fir 40° N 52° W 42 links down. (Found  
 figures on old B.T. fir 25° N 55° E 62 lks. all rite both for bear-  
 ing and distance. Found old B. T. a fir 24° S 37° E 72 lks no  
 trace but found fir with spot S 58° E 72 lks. Old B.T. S 33° W  
 75 lks. marked Oak post C. S. and set by side of stone which I  
 planted for corner. ~~marked a fir C.S.B.T. S 5° E 10 lks. Marked~~  
 a fir C.S.B.T. N 30° W 32 lks.

 Jas. Patten on Old B. T. as above described when his place was  
 surveyed By C.M. Collier several years ago. Found old B.T. a  
 fir 36° S 33° W 53 links standing with figures ¼ S visible. Tree  
 in poor condition on account of pitch. Drove post on top of  
 large fir log for corner.  
 A fir 4" dia. marked C.S.B.T. brs N 33° E 55 lks.  
 " 22" " " " " " " S 72° W 19 " figures placed in  
 new round wood on the North side of dead center which seems to  
 be rapidly covering the dead part.
