HE MENTIONS A STAKE AT THE S.W. COR.  
BUT SAYS HE CAN FIND NO TRACE OF  
ORIG. B.T.'S (2 FIRS). PRESENT INVEST-  
IGATION SHOWS NO TRACE OF ANY  
OAKS NEAR THE LOCATION OF THE S.W.  
COR., BUT PLENTY OF EVIDENCE OF OLD  
FIRS, SOME OVER 100 YRS OLD.

ALSO, THE FENCE COR. USED AS  
THE N.W. COR. OF D.L.C. 51, FALLS LESS  
THAN 10 FT. FROM COR. SET FROM THIS  
TREE.
