NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

OF A 0.186 ACRE PARCEL OF GROUND IN SEC. 34, T.32 S., R.6 W.W.M.,  
DOUGLAS COUNTY, OREGON., FOR C.J. AND E.M. SETHER, GLENDALE, ORE.

This survey was made at the request of Mr. C.J. Sether for  
the purpose of transferring title to the present owner of the  
adjoining Lot 7 of THE FORTY-NINER TRACT.

Used a transit, long band chain, and range pole, with  
the assistance of Mr. Sether. Bearing of lines, location of  
the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner and other information were taken from the FORTY-  
NINER TRACT plat as recorded.

DESCRIPTION

Beginning at an iron pipe, at a point on the prolonged  
easterly extension of the southerly line of THE FORTY -NINER  
TRACT at 25 feet from the southeast corner of Lot 7, said point  
also being S.21°-35'W., 413.38 feet from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between  
section 34 and section 35, T.32 S., R 6 W.W.M., thence  
N. 29°-37'W., 325.6 feet to an iron pipe, thence  
S.60°-25' W., 25 feet to an iron pipe, thence along the  
easterly boundry of Lot 7 of THE FORTY - NINER TRACT,  
S. 29°- 37'E., 325.6 feet to an iron pipe, thence  
N.60°-25'E., 25 feet to an iron pipe, the point of  
beginning, containing 0.186 acre, all in section 34, T.32 S.,  
R.6 W.W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.
