Dear Mr. Byron:

I have scribed a new bearing tree on the NW 1/16 corner, Sec. 28, T.32S., R.7W. since one of the two existing trees will be removed soon in road construction. The corner, set in 1956 - *c.s. 42/142* by Norman Price, called for the following:

a $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 36" Iron Pipe (42" deep) from which
bears a-

D.F. 6" N 14° W 102 lks. (to be removed)
D.F. 12" S 23° E 147 lks.

These trees were found to be 13.4" and 16.5" DBH; scribing was seen. The point of intersection of the two distances fall at the edge of an old logging spur road; a search revealed no iron pipe and none was set since new construction will fill over at the corner.

A Sun Shot was taken to determine bearings because given bearings were considerably different than compass bearings noted. New bearings were:

D.F. 6" N 28° 33' 50" W 102 lks. (to be removed)
D.F. 12" S 11° 48' 50" E 147 lks.

These bearings fit the direction of faces on the two trees scribed in 1956.

The new B.T. scribed by me is:

Ponderosa Pine 18.0" DBH N 34° 25' 40" E 208.1 lks.
Mkd. NW 1/16, S. 28, T.32S., R.7W., RS 841, B.T.
