

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Closing corner common to Sections 30 and 31, T22S, R10W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 36" x 20" x 10" (in place, CC on west, 5 notches on north, and 2 notches on east) from which a:

- 8" Fir bears N58°E 60 lks.; now 23" in place, face grown over (bearing N63E).
- 6" Fir bears S65°E 20 lks.; now 29" in place, face grown over.
- 4" Fir bears N46°W 35 lks.; now missing.

RESTORATION (Not recorded)

29" Fir bears S75°W 10 ft.; scribe 0 exposed, approximately 18 years old by ring count.

RESTORED

Set 4" x 4" x 72" white painted Cedar post N80°E 2.6 ft. from above described stone, from which a:

- 20" Fir bears S33 1/2°E 44.9 ft. to face; scribed T22S R10W S31 CC BT.
- 23" Fir (orig.) bears N63°E 40 ft. to face; scribed RS 359.

Set 4" x 4" x 72" white painted Cedar post 2.6 ft. N80°E of corner stone. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 29" Fir BT (orig.) S65°E 12.3 ft.
