Deed Description filed May 12, 1972, and bearing S. $82^{\circ}39'18''$ W. $50.22'$
from fd. axle, the S.W. Cor. of Oak Grove Park Survey described above
and also bearing N. $73^{\circ}50'42''$ E. a distance of $2145.90'$ from the S.W.
Cor. of James Cox D.L.C. No. 44; thence N. $86^{\circ}30'31''$ W. a distance
of $61.76'$, where I set a $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 30" Iron Rod; thence N. $1^{\circ}45'43''$ W.
