NEW BEARING OBJECT

A BOAT SPIKE, DRIVEN IN THE

BEARS N 64° W 33' FT.

THIS CORNER LIES ON STEEP SLOPE  
NEAR THE BOTTOM OF AND APPROX. 150'  
NORTH OF A RAVINE IN A RECENTLY  
LOGGED AREA.
