

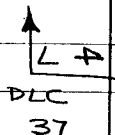

BASED ON INFORMATION SUPPLIED TO THE  
COUNTY SURVEYOR, WE FIND A MONUMENT NOT  
OF RECORD. THE MONUMENT FOUND IS A BRASS  
CAP, 1 INCH IN DIAMETER, SET IN CONCRETE AND  
FLUSH WITH THE SURFACE OF THE GROUND,  
MARKED:



WE FIND NO RECORD OF THIS MONUMENT IN  
THE RECORDS OF THE DOUGLAS COUNTY SURVEYOR.

TO PRESERVE THE LOCATION OF THIS MONUMENT,  
WE MARK THE FOLLOWING BEARING TREES;

OF LOYAL E. TRUESDALE

AND A 20" SPRUCE BEARS  $N 40^{\circ} E$   $39 \frac{5}{8}$  FT.  
SCRIBED "RP CSBT"

AT THIS TIME, WE SEARCH FOR THE NE EXTERIOR  
"L" CORNER OF DLC 37 WHICH WAS REPORTEDLY  
FOUND IN 1925 (SEE REN. # 4), HOWEVER WE  
FIND NO TRACE OF THIS CORNER. (NOTE THAT  
THE MEASUREMENTS QUOTED IN REN. 4 DO  
NOT CORRESPOND WITH THE ORIGINAL  
SURVEY NOTES.) THIS SEARCH WAS  
BASED ON THE LOCATION OF THE  
AFOREMENTIONED UNRECORDED MONUMENT.

NOTE:

THE UNRECORDED MONUMENT WHICH WE FIND  
IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY EDGE  
OF THE CEMETARY AT THE NORTH END OF  
THE TOWN OF GARDNER, APPROX. 1 FOOT  
EAST OF THE RETAINING WALL ALONG THE  
UPPER WALKWAY AND APPROX.  $2 \frac{5}{8}$  FT NORTH  
OF THE TOMBSTONE FOR LOYAL E. TRUESDALE.
