RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, T19S, R8W, W.M., Douglas and Lane Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing) from which a:

- 18" Alder bears N14°E 24 lks.; now 30" stump with tree rotted off.
- 8" Maple bears S60°E 38 lks.; now 21" with face open and old axe work visible.
- 8" Alder bears S41°W 43 lks.; now missing.
- 4" Vine Maple bears N42°W 50 lks.; now missing.
- Stream 3 lks. wide, course East, bears South 6 chains (now 520 ft).
- Ridge West 7.25 chs, course North & South, and broad on top (now 450 feet).
- Ridge North 10 chains, course East and West, with broad top (now 700 feet).

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T19S R8W S5 S6 S7 S8 1976 RS563", 6 inches in ground, in mound of rock, and from which a:

- 20" Hemlock bears S26°W 63.9 ft. to face; scribed T19S R8W S7 BT RS563.
- 20" Maple bears N19°W 64.6 ft. to face; scribed T19S R8W S6 BT.
- 72" Fir bears N11°E 75.6 ft. to face; scribed in bark T19S R8W S5 BT.
- No trees within limits in SE quadrant.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 5.0 ft. NW of corner pipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on original 8" Maple BT. Also poster on 30" Fir stump West 370 ft. on East side of Dun Ridge Road.
