I find a 1 inch outside diameter pipe with a brass cap attached, from which the one remaining bearing tree, a

White Fir 24" diam. bears record S 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^oE. 20.5 ft.

I perpetuate the corner position by taking the following new tree and place a brass washer bearing my registration No. in the lower blaze:

A D. Fir 8" diam. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT bears N 41^oE. 70.1 ft.
